



The BACW's Bidding Commission hereby present questions made by companies with their respective answers.

REMARK: The questions presented in this "Questions and Answers" shall be numbered as they are received by the Bidding Commission and may not match the numbering provided by the companies.

Therefore, the Bidding Commission has answered previous questions on July 18, 2017 and August 21, 2017 and they are published on BACW's website.

Question 16 – Answer to question 15 as follows does not answer my doubt.: Your Answer – In accordance with the Items 11.1 and 11.2.6 of the CLAUSE 11 – PRICE PROPOSAL REVIEW, of the Invitation for Bid 171745/CABW/2017:

"11.1. The criterion to review the price proposal shall be the LOWEST GLOBAL PRICE PER MODULE.

"11.2 Proposals shall be DISQUALIFIED if:

"11.2.6 The BIDDER shall not present unit prices for a specific MODULE, if the BIDDER is not able to present prices for all items in this related MODULE."

We will be providing price. Our Manufacturer does not make those few ITEMS, We will purchase for resale from a different manufacturer, we will provide price, tech data and documents on the offered line item.

If we do not manufacture one ITEM out of 95, would that make the INTENTION TO SUB-CONTRACT THE WHOLE MODULE AS SUB-CONTRACTING? THE PART 3 ON THE Attached IV is just a YES or NO question which does not allows to states per ITEM or percentage.

In other words, If I have less than 1 % items to source out of our manufacturer will that answer will be "NO" to the intend to manufacture?

Answer – If the BIDDER subcontracts any of the Items from any of the Modules, regardless of the quantity, the BIDDER shall fill out Part 3 of annex IV of the Invitation for Bid 171745/CABW/2017 the notice "YES" on the respective Module.
