MEETING MINUTES 055/CPL/2018
REQUEST FOR QUOTE Nº 184705/CABW/2018

At 9:00 a.m. (EST) on November 6th, 2018, the Brazilian Aeronautical Commission's (BACW) Bidding Commission held a meeting for the Bidding n. 184705/CABW/2018 to be awarded based on the GREATEST GLOBAL PRICE, for selling **11 (eleven) Mirage 2000 aircraft (Project F-2000)**, in no-flight condition, in accordance with the solicitation package.

For this open session 138 (one hundred and thirty-eight) companies were invited, as well as the Embassies of the following countries were notified about this solicitation: Egypt, United Arab Emirates, Greece, India, Peru, Qatar, Taiwan, and France.

At this point, before receiving the envelopes from the present companies, the Bidding Commission interrupted this open session in order to check if there was any envelope received for this solicitation at BACW's Protocol Department.

As a result, no envelope was received at BACW's Protocol Department.

The company **GLOBAL AVIATION, LLC** hand delivered its envelope and had Ms. Vanessa K. Mansur as its legal representative.

The Bidding Commission complied with all requirements necessary to achieve the minimum of 3 (three) proposals for this bidding process. On BACW's website, for instance, the publishing of this bidding process was viewed 1627 times at the time of this meeting and the solicitation package was downloaded 514 times.

Moreover, in accordance with item 9.6 of the Invitation for Bid 174013/CABW/2017, since the minimum requirement of 3 (three) participating bidders was not met in this open session, the solicitation shall be republished for a later date.

Subsequently, Ms. Vanessa K. Mansur expressed its desire to not deliver the envelope from **GLOBAL AVIATION, LLC** to the Bidding Commission at this meeting.

At this point it is important to register that companies that performed SURVEY on the aircrafts as per item 9 of the IFB are not required to perform new surveys for the republishing.

The republishing of the Invitation For Bid is considered a new bidding. Therefore, any interested company may participate.



The Bidding Commission shall inquire the Brazilian Air Force Logistics Center (CELOG) regarding the new date for the republishing of this Bidding Process.

Having complied with all due legal and administrative procedures, the President of the Bidding Commission closes the meeting, from which these minutes are derived, for signature by all meeting participants and further incorporation into the Bidding file ("PAG") N° 67102.184705.2018-31.
